New Developments with Stem Cells From Teeth


These days it seems that not a week goes by without another story in the media about the incredible regenerative power of adult stem cells. And it isn't surprising, because the global scientific community has recognised the potential for this completely holistic style of medicine – where the body is enabled to repair itself. Development could make a dramatic change to the degenerative disease burden of cancer, diabetes, cardiovascular diseases, Parkinson's and many, many more.

In April 2012, www.clinicaltrials. gov listed no less than 3,739 current studies on stem cell therapies.

Evidence now shows that stem cells are found in the umbilical cord, umbilical blood, bone marrow and the teeth – which contain more stem cells than some other sources and are by far the most natural, non-invasive source of stem cells. It was just nine years ago that a US researcher discovered that there were stem cells in dental pulp. These are special cells, which do not provoke immune reactions. These cells are capable of changing into different tissues such as bone, cartilage, nerve tissue and muscle. *continued overleaf...*

Lorraine's Top Five Tips For A Healthy Mouth

- 1. Brush twice daily with a fluoride toothpaste but DO NOT RINSE!!
- 2. Clean between your teeth with tooth pick, floss or little brushes once a day to remove debris your toothbrush does not reach. (30-40% is left in gaps)
- Stop Smoking.... Lots of help available! You are 2 times more likely to lose your teeth if you smoke and 6 times more likely to develop gum disease.
- 4. Do not snack on sugary foods, fizzy drinks or fruit juices in between meals. These can increase risk of high levels of tooth decay. This includes sugary Tea and Coffee.
- 5. Chew sugar free chewing gum after meals and drink lots of water during the day.
